

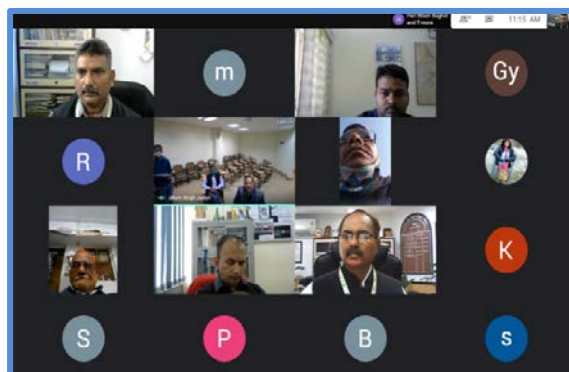
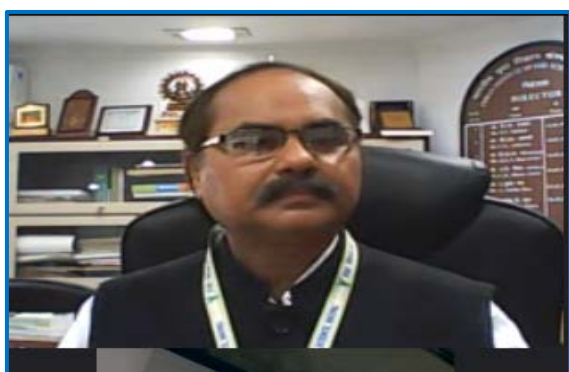
ICAR-IISS and SIAET, Bhopal Jointly organized a Online Training on 'Soil Health Management'

A 4 day online Training programme on 'Soil Health Management' was organized jointly by ICAR-Indian Institute of Soil Science (IISS), Bhopal and State Institute of Agricultural Extension & Training (SIAET), Bhopal during 19-22 Jan 2021. **Dr Ashok K Patra**, Director, ICAR-IISS, Bhopal and **Shri G.P.Prajapati**, Director, SIAET, Bhopal graced the inaugural session. More than 30 State Government Officials from different parts of Madhya Pradesh virtually participated in the programme.

On this occasion, **Dr Patra**, Director, ICAR-IISS, Bhopal, emphasized the importance of soil health and its role in food security and environmental safety.
